PURPOSE:

The Environmental Justice Small Grants Program (EJSG) provides funding for projects that address local environmental and health issues within an affected community. An “affected community,” for the purposes of this assistance agreement program, is defined as a vulnerable community that is disproportionately impacted by environmental harms and risks and has a local environmental and public health issue. The EJSG program is designed to help communities understand and address exposure to multiple environmental harms and risks.

MAIN CRITERIA:

All proposed projects should include activities designed to educate, empower and enable communities to understand environmental and public health issues and to identify ways to address these issues at the local level as they relate to these seven statutes

-Clean Water Act [Section 104 (b) (3)] , **Safe Drinking Water Act** [Section 1442 (c) (3)], **Solid Waste Disposal Act:** [Section 8001 (a)], **Clean Air Act** [Section 103 (b) (3)], **Toxic Substances Act** [Section 10 (a)], **Federal Insecticide Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act,** [Section 20(a)], **Marine Protection, Research, and Sanctuaries Act** [Section 203]

Eligible applicants include: incorporated non-profit organizations—including, but not limited to, environmental justice networks, faith based organizations and those affiliated with religious institutions; federally recognized tribal governments; OR tribal organizations

AWARD AMOUNT: up to \$25,000
